What is ASTEF?

Who runs ASTEF?

► In 2022, ASTEF awarded \$3,000 in scholarships, \$6,500 in competitive stipends for aspiring educators and \$14,982.00 in project stipends for a total of \$24,482.

Kappa Phi Projects

Early Educator Grants

Based on DKG's focus on supporting early educators, Kappa Phi established an Early Educator Grant Program to endow grants to fund classroom resources such as: books, manipulatives, learning games, adaptive special education materials, software licenses, etc.

Funds to support the project are provided by our annual Christmas auction and pot-luck dinner. Four grants of \$250.00 are awarded each year to early educators who are starting their 1st to 5th year of teaching. Applications are accepted in the Fall of 2022 and awarded in January 2023 at the Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD school board meeting.

Our chapter's choice for grants to early educators provides an opportunity for the recipient to be creative, to meet classroom needs, and to support students. It is tangible and from the applications we have received, we have seen that this is a much-needed use of our funds.

The Bea Salazar Project

How did we get to champion Bea Salazar? It started when CFBISD initiated their Adopt-a-Teacher initiative several years ago. The district established contacts with district teachers who were looking for a boost of caring and support as they struggled through a difficult year with COVID 19, divided instruction, and "what comes next "frustration. Folks in the Carrollton community as well as fellow educators donated items to a teacher listed in the Adopt-a-Teacher that were requested for them classroom. This was a big success as folks reached out to over 1500 educators, custodians, bus drivers etc. Kappa Phi adopted several educators, purchased items for them and delivered them to the schools. And then, Vicky Herr, a Kappa Phi member, had someone mention to her that the alternative educators/staff at Bea Salazar School received very little support. She thought that adopting the whole school might help the staff know they are valued. The staff consists of 33 hard working folks who have no PTSA or outside community support. With that, Kappa Phi jumped on the aboard and the Bea Project was born.

The Bea Project is providing reinforcement for their work and effort as they work with students who are struggling with academics or have had an incident at their school that required a time-out. The Buzz for Bea is shepherded by Debbie Moss and Vicky Herr. The times for taking treats are Late October, Early December, and February or March, and Early May.
